#### LOOKING BACK 8<sup>TH</sup> M-POHL MEETING

On 14th June the 8th M-POHL Meeting was attended by 43 participants from 16 countries, representing research and policy perspectives. In addition, Katrine Habersaat and Anastasia Koylyu were participating on behalf of WHO-Europe, and an Asian observer was attending the meeting too. The main results of the HLS<sub>19</sub> survey from 17 countries and, based on the results, first suggestions for recommendations on policy and partly on research were presented. These policy suggestions were discussed and further developed in small groups. Additionally, a suggestion on taking population HL surveys further towards regular and periodical HL measurement was presented by the ICC. A draft of the Minutes was sent out on 21<sup>st</sup> June for feedback.

#### INVITATION TO THE 9<sup>TH</sup> M-POHL MEETING ON 23<sup>RD</sup> AUGUST 2021

We are pleased to invite you to the 9<sup>th</sup> M-POHL Meeting on 23<sup>rd</sup> August from 13:00 to 17:00 CET. This meeting will be organised in form of a workshop and will follow up on the work on developing recommendations for policy, practice and research on improving health literacy on the population level that was started at the 8<sup>th</sup> M-POHL meeting. Again, the meeting will be held online via Zoom. A detailed suggestion for an agenda will be sent out a week before the meeting including all relevant meeting details. The main aim of the meeting will be to continue developing the recommendations by consenting on the draft recommendations chapter in the International Report that will be developed in July and August and shared with the consortium before the meeting.

#### PROGRESS IN HLS<sub>19</sub> DATA COLLECTION AND DATA ANALYSES

Data analyses including the Bulgarian and the Italian data, which were delivered in May 2021, were completed by the ICC, and all analyses can be found in DORY.

# HLS<sub>19</sub> INTERNATIONAL REPORTING

Tremendous work on the optional packages has been done by the optional packages chapter leads and their co-author groups, so chapters are already very advanced. The ICC has started involving co-authors on some chapters and sending out first chapters for data check and completing to the principal investigators and their research teams. This process will be ongoing all summer but with some interruptions due to the holiday season. The texting of the chapter on recommendation for policy, practice and research will also happen during the next couple of months.
